
## Discerning of Spirits 4 - Discernment through knowledge

Ezekiel 44:23 "And they shall <u>teach</u> My people the difference between the holy and the unholy, and cause them to <u>discern</u> between the unclean and the clean.



## Discerning of Spirits defined:

- Strong's: to separate thoroughly
- Vine's: to distinguish or have clear discrimination
- Young's: A thorough judging

Gordon Lindsey: "Supernatural enablement, permitting identification of the nature and character of spirits, seen and unseen"

Philippians 1:9-10 And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, 10 that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ,

## Power of teaching on discernment: Teach what you want to have

Faith comes by hearing ... you will be able to have more discernment in the future

Hebrews 5:12-14 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food.

13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe.

14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to <u>discern</u> both good and evil.

Hebrews 4:12-13 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.
