(How we can fulfill His mission on the earth)

- 1. Obedience to His call (Matthew 28:18-20)
- 2. Recognize the Status of the world (John 4:34-38)
- 3. Dependence upon God for results (1 Corinthians 3:5-6)
- 4. Pray to the Lord of the harvest (Luke 10:2)

### 5. Relying on the power of the Holy spirit (Acts 1:8)

<sup>8</sup> But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

## 6. Be lead by the Holy spirit (Acts 1:8)

#### Acts 16:6-10

6 Now when they had gone through Phrygia and the region of Galatia, they were forbidden by the Holy Spirit to preach the word in Asia. 7 After they had come to Mysia, they tried to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit did not permit them. 8 So passing by Mysia, they came down to Troas. 9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night. A man of Macedonia stood and pleaded with him, saying, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." 10 Now after he had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go to Macedonia, concluding that the Lord had called us to preach the gospel to them.



### 7. Home groups\School of ministry

Acts 19:8-10<sup>8</sup> And he went into the synagogue and spoke boldly for three months, reasoning and persuading concerning the things of the kingdom of God. <sup>9</sup> But when some were hardened and did not believe, but spoke evil of the Way before the multitude, he departed from them and <u>withdrew the disciples</u>, reasoning daily in the school of Tyrannus. <sup>10</sup> And this continued for two years, so that <u>all who dwelt in Asia</u> heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.

### Acts 20:17-21

<sup>17</sup> From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called for the elders of the church. <sup>18</sup> And when they had come to him, he said to them: "You know, from the first day that I came to Asia, in what manner I always lived among you, <sup>19</sup> serving the Lord with all humility, with many tears and trials which happened to me by the plotting of the Jews; <sup>20</sup> how I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and <u>taught you publicly and from house to house</u>, <sup>21</sup> testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.

### Acts 2:46-47

<sup>46</sup> So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, <sup>47</sup> praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

# 8. Gift of Evangelist
