1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing,

Mark 9:14-28

• This kind does not go out but by prayer and fasting

• They obviously were not praying or fasting, at least in combination

• Some things will not happen without prayer

Acts 1:14; 2:1-4

- Many people are trying to do the works of Jesus without praying like Jesus!
- Many times we get a formula down pat and we rely on it instead of the power of the Holy Spirit energized by prayer.
- We operate in the flesh and run our own lives instead of operating in the Spirit and are lead by the Spirit!

Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

- Prayer changes people and circumstances
- We need to live in prayer, not just pray in a time of crisis
- If we pray before we hear and avert disaster. If we pray only in crisis we are running a clean up operation.


God Chasers prayer meeting (Tuesday 6-7 am)
