

Prophecy – How to Bring your words to pass

Principles for Bringing words to pass

1. Be obedient and diligent to what God told you to do

1Timothy 4:14,15 Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership.

15 Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all.

2. Write it down (keep a journal) and meditate on it. Speak it out loud, pray it, war with it.

1Timothy 1:18 This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare,

3. Exercise faith and patience

Hebrews 6:11 And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end, 12 that you do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.
